**1. Two courses (8 units) must be taken from:** AHS 260, AHS 273, AHS 274, CRWT 186A, CRWT 186B, ENTL 117T, ENGL 120T, ENGL 151T, ENGL 152, ENGL 246, ENGL 250, ENGL 260, ENGL 272, ENGL 273, ENGL 282, FREN 160, HISE 113, HISE 114, HISE 197, HIST 240 (E-Z), HIST 262, HIST 263.

Students may ask to count another course with relevant content as approved by the Designated Emphasis Directors. Students must select courses from at least two different departments or programs, one of which may be their home department. Undergraduate courses taken to fulfill these requirements must be accompanied by a 2-unit 292 course with extra work mutually agreed upon by professor and student.
